A corporation not for profit may be formed hereunder for any purpose or purposes not involving pecuniary gain or profit for which natural persons may lawfully associate themselves, provided that when the General Code makes special provision for the filing of articles of incorporation of designated classes of corporations not for profit, such corporations shall be formed under such provisions and not hereunder.

§603.98. Any number of persons, not less than three, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, may become a corporation not for profit by subscribing, executing and filing in the office of the secretary of state articles of incorporation, hereinafter called "articles," setting forth:

1. The name of the corporation;
2. The place in this state where the principal office of the corporation is to be located;
3. The names and postoffice addresses of its trustees, not less than three, who are to serve until the first annual meeting or other meeting called for that purpose;
4. The names and postoffice addresses of its trustees, not less than three, who are to serve until the first annual meeting or other meeting called for that purpose;
5. If desired, the names of any persons who, together with the subscribers to the articles, are to be members of the corporation upon organization;
6. If desired, any qualifications for membership in such corporation;
7. Any lawful provision which may be desired for the purpose of defining, limiting or regulating the exercise of the powers of the corporation, and of the trustees and of the members, or of any class of members, and for the purpose of creating or defining rights and privileges of the members among themselves. Any provision authorized by the statute in the regulations of such corporation may, if desired, be included in its articles.
